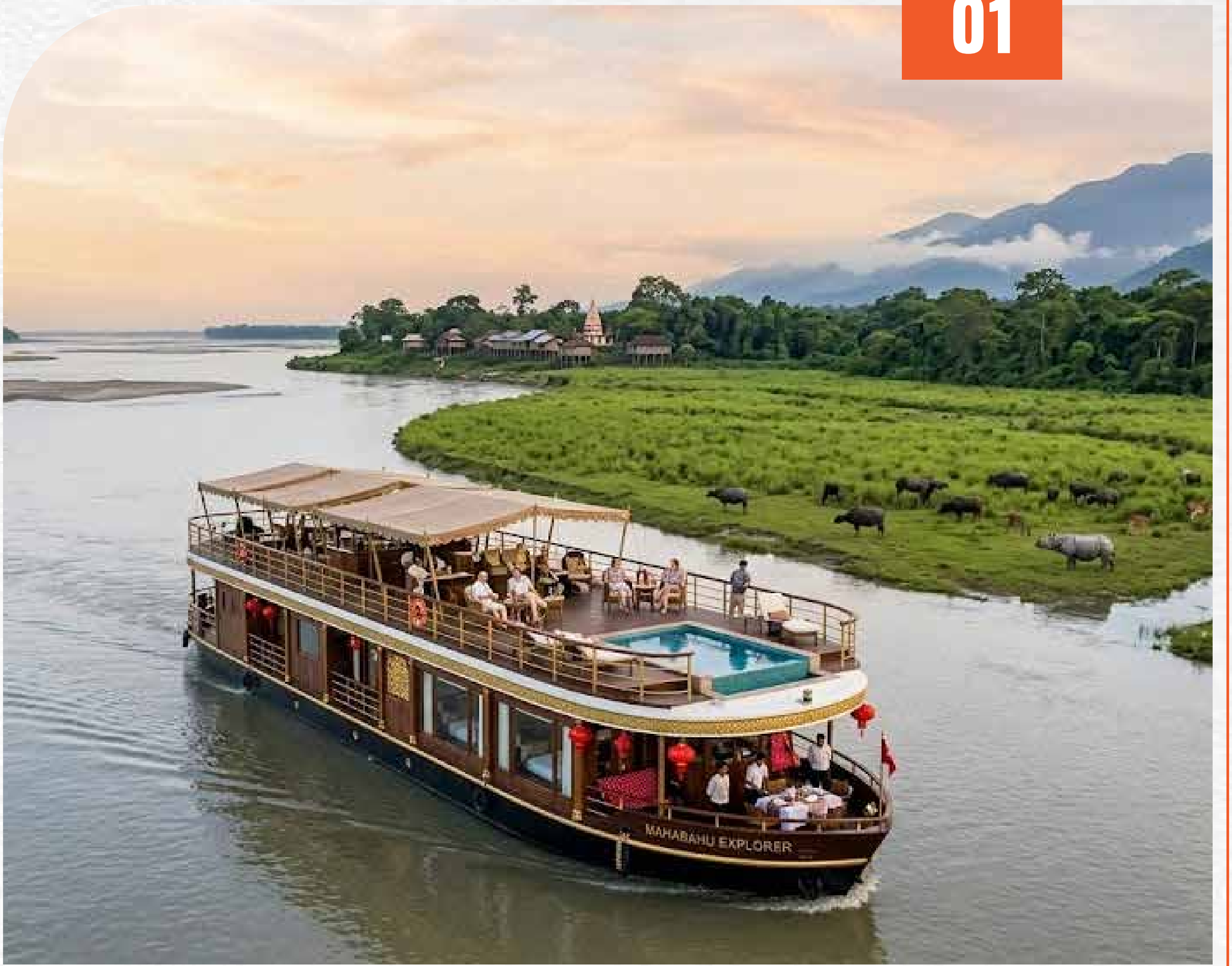

Over View

The worship of feminine power in ancient India is deeply ingrained in the mythology and history of the Ambubachi Mela. It revolves around the hallowed Kamakhya Temple, a temple strongly connected to Tantric and Shakti worship. Hindu mythology claims that the tale of Goddess Sati and Lord Shiva is where this location first appeared. Following Sati's self-sacrifice, Shiva grievously carried her body throughout the cosmos, with fragments of her body falling in various locations to establish the revered Shakti Peethas. Kamakhya is a potent hub of fertility and creation since it is thought that the womb and yoni, a symbol of feminine creation, dropped there. The temple and the celebration have been significant historically since ancient times, particularly under the patronage of local dynasties such as the Koch monarchs, who restored the temple in the sixteenth century after it had collapsed. Ambubachi Mela, which coincides with Assam's monsoon season and agricultural cycle, has developed over generations into a distinctive celebration of the planet's fertility. Early cultural traditions that regarded natural reproductive processes as sacred rather than impure are reflected in the idea that the goddess goes through an annual menstrual period during this time.

Ascetics, mystics, and spiritual searchers who adhere to esoteric forms of worship are drawn to the mela because it has long been linked to Tantric traditions. Ambubachi, which combines tribal customs, local beliefs, and ancient Hindu philosophy, emphasises the unadulterated, creative power of nature and the divine feminine, in contrast to many other Hindu celebrations. In addition to being a significant religious event, it now serves as a living example of traditional spiritual concepts that celebrate life's cyclical cycles, fertility, and metamorphosis.



Arrival at Guwahati

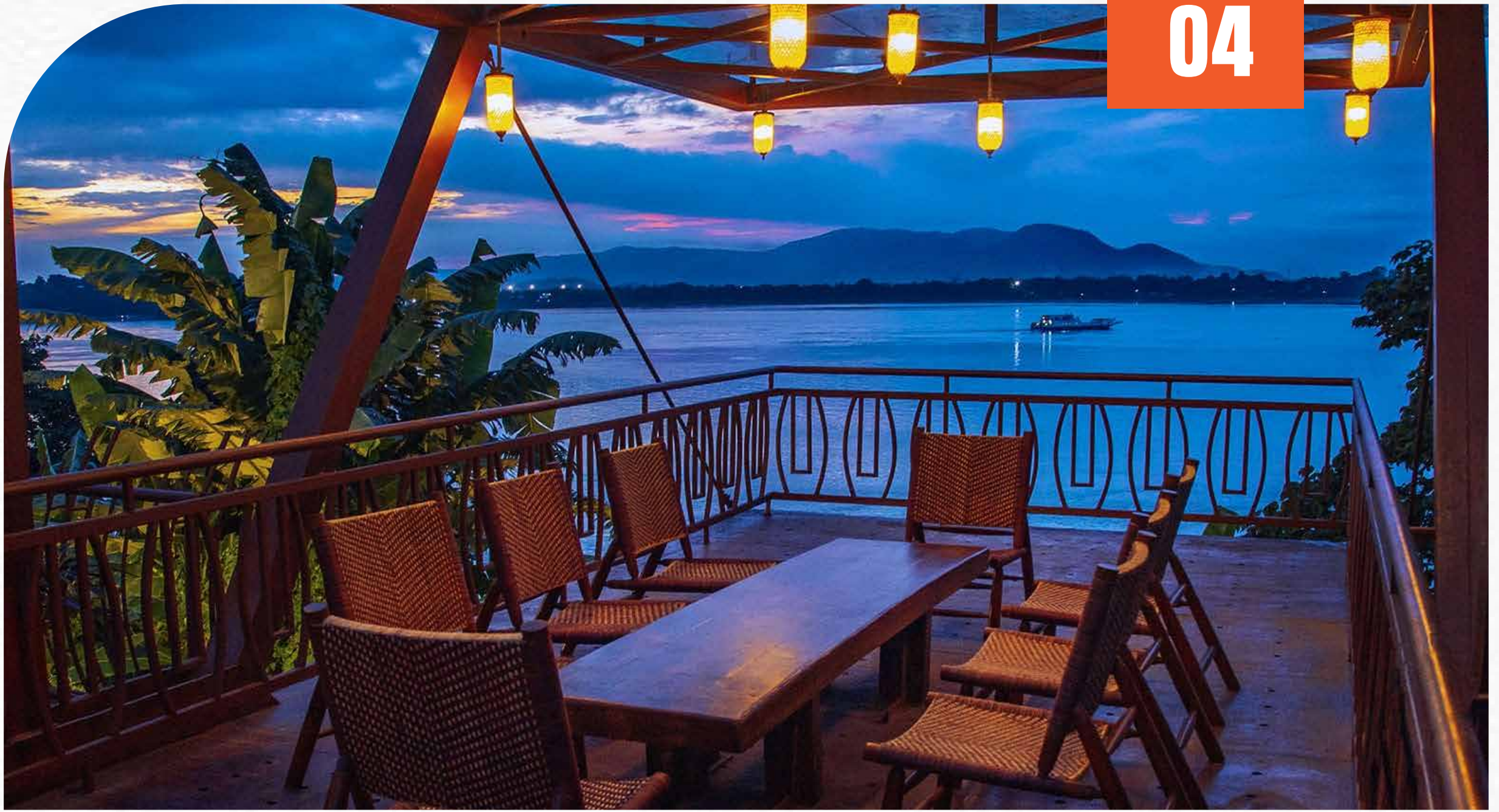
It is going to be absolutely crowded with devotees during Ambubachi Mela. And overnight stay at hotel



Balaji Temple , Basistha Shivalay & River Cruise

On the 3rd day, have a filling breakfast and head out to Balaji Temple. The vehicle will drop you at the premises. The vehicle will be on stand-by for you. In the morning , visit the **Balaji Temple**. Dedicated to Lord Venkateswara, Purva Tirupati Sri Balaji Mandir was built in the year 1998. Sprawling over 2 acres, the temple is considered as the replica of the original Tirupati Balaji Temple. This white colored temple is built in the similar architectural style of the South Indian temples. The temple has a Rajagopuram (70 feet in-height), a Maha Mandapam, an Ardha Mandapam, and the Sanctorum. Following that visit to Basistha Shivalaya. (If time permits short hike to Garbanga Forest)

In the evening, head out for the dining experience at the **Brahmaputra River Cruise**. Overnight Stay at Hotel



Spiritual Journey through Guwahati

On the 4th day of your trip, head out to explore Guwahati.

Start your day with a visit to the Umananda Temple. The Umananda Temple is located in the smallest inhabited River Island. Take a ferry from the Umananda Ghat to reach the Temple.

Visit **Ugra Tara Temple** which is a second Shakti Peet In Guwahati.

After exploring the Ugra Tara Temple head to Mahababu **Brahmaputra River Heritage Center**. The Mahabahu Brahmaputra River Heritage Center is dedicated to the spirit and legacy of the majestic River Brahmaputra. The tree lined walkways leading to the this pedestrian only campus, with an Art Garden, a 170 years old Heritage Bungalow, an open air Amphitheatre along with a modern glass façade building functioning as a Café, and the Riverside Garden with the open grass patches set amidst trees, with art installations, specially designed activity spaces and viewing decks overlooking the river, are landscaped in a way to refresh the senses

After a spiritual day at Guwahati, head back to your stay and rest well.



Maa Kamakhya Darshan

Today, you'll need to wake up and leave early for Maa Kamakhya darshan. Today, Maa Kamakhya Temple reopens after ritual period, this is the most sacred time.

The vehicle will drop you at the foothill of Maa Kamakhya Temple. There are no VIP passes available

Darshan Strategy

- Be among the earliest in the queue.
- Expect 4 – 6 hours minimum, in the queue, even with early arrival.

- Angodak / Angabastra (holy prasad)

Post Darshan, head back to your hotel and relax.
