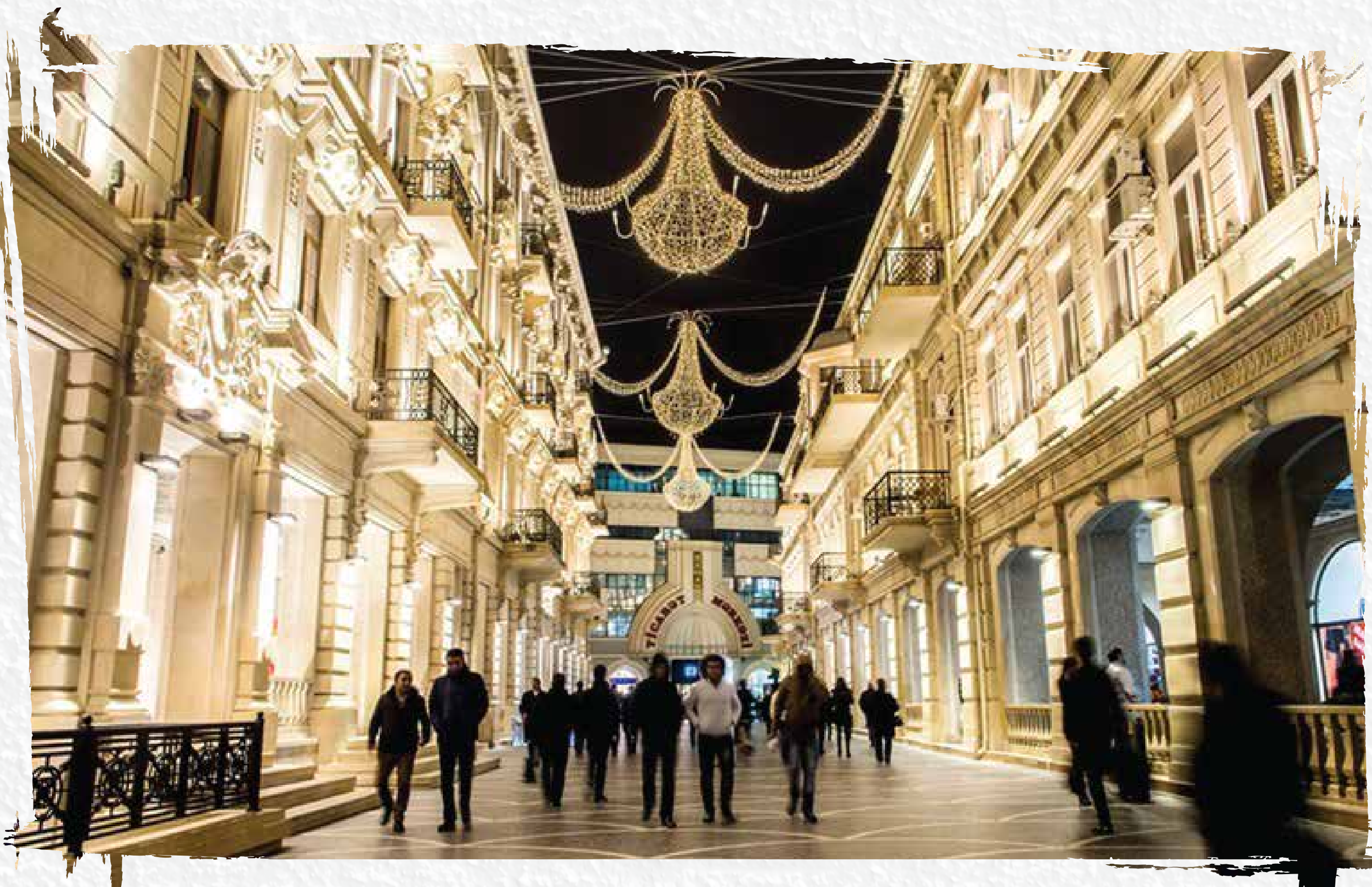

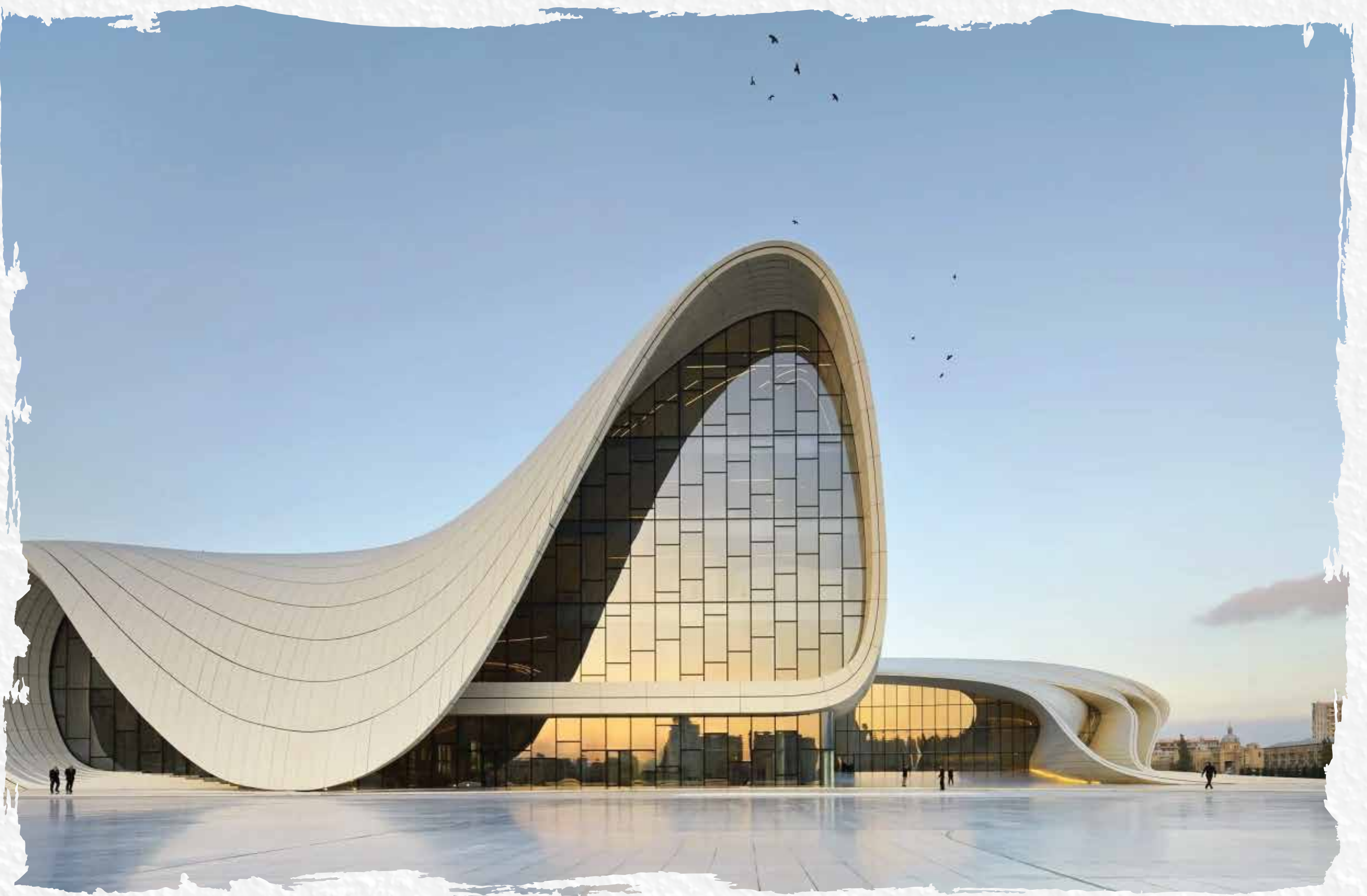

- **Fountains Square** – is a public square in downtown Baku, capital of Azerbaijan. The square was previously called Parapet and is often referenced as the same name now. The name of the fountains square derives from the presence of dozens of fountains throughout the square first constructed during Soviet rule of Azerbaijan. It is an attractive tourist destination with many boutiques, restaurants, shops, hotels and passage.
- **The Heydar Aliyev Center**(Entry Included), located in Baku, Azerbaijan, is a striking architectural masterpiece designed by the renowned architect Zaha Hadid. Opened in 2012, this 57,500 m² complex is named after Heydar Aliyev, a prominent Azerbaijani leader. Its innovative design features flowing, curved lines that eschew sharp angles, creating a sense of fluidity and grace. As a symbol of modernity and progress, the center houses exhibition spaces, conference halls, and a museum, showcasing the rich cultural heritage and achievements of Azerbaijan. With its captivating design and cultural significance, the Heydar Aliyev Center is a must-see attraction for visitors to Baku.

The mountain is a solid rock and is one of the most famous mountains in the Caucasus, known for its mythical stories. It is a sacred place for regular visitation by pilgrims. On the way observation
- **Shahdag** is a mountainous region located in the northeastern part of Azerbaijan, near the town of Gusar. It is renowned for its stunning natural beauty, rugged landscapes, and diverse recreational opportunities.

- **Start To Use Shahdag Activities.** The Shahdag Mountain Resort Complex Was Open To The Public In 2012. FLAME + GOBUSTAN TOUR

- **The Flame Temple**, also known as the Ateshgah of Baku, is a historic religious site located in Surakhani, just outside of Baku, Azerbaijan. Built during the 17th and 18th centuries, the temple is renowned for its unique architecture and religious significance. It was originally a Hindu and Zoroastrian place of worship, dedicated to the worship of fire. The temple complex features a central altar surrounded by cells and chambers, adorned with intricate carvings and inscriptions. Today, the Flame Temple stands as a testament to Azerbaijan's multicultural heritage and remains a popular tourist attraction in the region.
- **Fire Mountain, also known as Yanar Dag**, is a natural wonder located on the Absheron Peninsula near Baku, Azerbaijan. This fascinating site is renowned for its perpetually burning flames, which emerge from the natural gas seeping through the rocks. The flames, fueled by underground gas reservoirs, create a mesmerizing spectacle, particularly at night when they illuminate the surrounding landscape. Yanar Dag has been burning for centuries, earning it the nickname "Fire Mountain" and attracting visitors from around the world who come to witness this unique phenomenon.



- **Gobustan**, located approximately 64 kilometers southwest of Baku, **Azerbaijan**, is a **UNESCO World Heritage Site renowned for its ancient rock art and archaeological significance**. Dating back over 40,000 years, the site features thousands of petroglyphs carved into the rock faces, depicting scenes of daily life, hunting, dancing, and ritualistic ceremonies of prehistoric societies. Additionally, Gobustan is home to mud volcanoes, unique geological formations that add to its allure.
- **Mud volcanoes** are pervasive within the Republic of Azerbaijan. In local language, mud volcanoes are also known as "**pilpila**", "**yanardagh**", "**bozdagh**", "**akhtarma**", "**gaynarja**" etc. There are over 220 mud volcanoes in Azerbaijan (Absheron Peninsula, Gobustan, southeast Shirvan plain, Samur-Davachi plain terrane, both Absheron, and Baku Archipelago. The biggest are Galmas, Toraghay, Big Kanizadag, etc. Most of them have a cone shape.



- The **Bibi-Heybat Mosque** is a mosque, located in Baku, Azerbaijan. The existing structure, built in the 1990s, is a recreation of the mosque with the same name built in the 13th century by Shirvanshah Farrukhzad II Ibn Ahsitan II, which was completely destroyed by the Bolsheviks in 1934. The Bibi-Heybat Mosque includes the tomb of Ukeyma Khanum (a descendant of The Islamic Prophet Muhammad), and today is the spiritual center for the Muslims of the region and one of the major monuments of Islamic architecture in Azerbaijan. It is sometimes known as "the mosque of Fatima", which is what Alexandre Dumas called it when he described the mosque during his visit in the 1850s. **(Photostop outside)**
- The world's first industrially drilled oil well – The petroleum industry in Azerbaijan produced about 33 million tonnes of oil and 35 billion cubic meters of gas in 2022. Azerbaijan is one of the birthplaces of the oil industry. The State Oil Company of the Republic of Azerbaijan (SOCAR), a fully state-owned national oil and gas company headquartered in Baku, is a major source of income for the Azerbaijani government.
